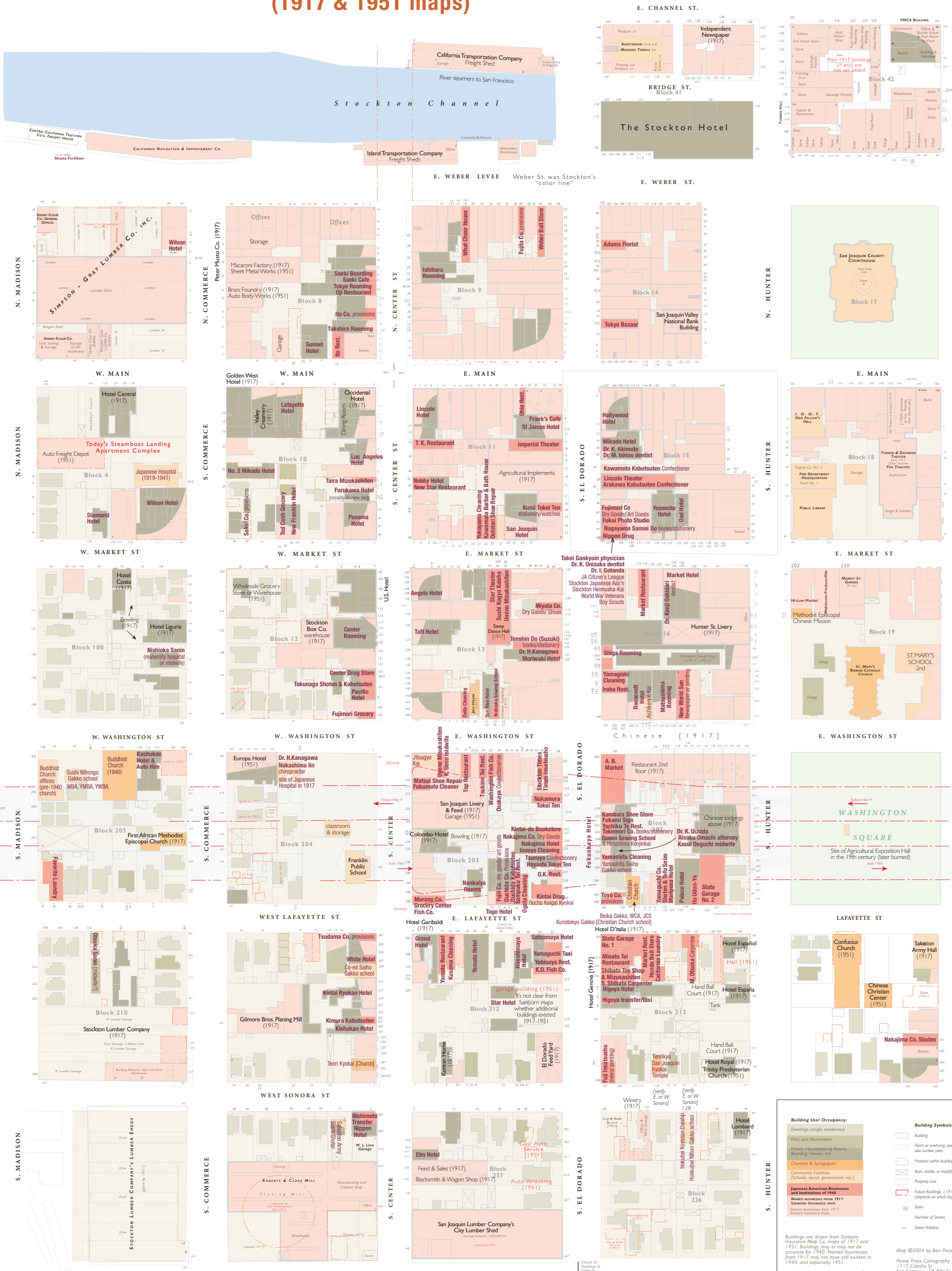


# Stockton's Japantown, Chinatown, & Little Manila

**Building Use Occupancy:**

- Dwellings (single residences)
- Hotels, Housekeeping Rooms, Boarding Houses, etc.
- Churches & Synagogues
- Community Facilities (schools, social, government, etc.)
- Japanese American Businesses and Institutions of 1940
- Named Businesses from 1917 Sanborn Insurance Maps
- Generic Businesses from 1917 Sanborn Insurance Maps

**Building Symbols:**

- Building
- Part or overhang open also lumber piles
- Partition within building
- Iron, stable, or hayrack
- Property Line
- Future Buildings (1917) (depends on which year)
- Stairs
- Number of Stories
- Street Address

Buildings are drawn from Sanborn Insurance Map Co. maps of 1917 and 1951. Buildings may or may not be accurate for 1940. Named businesses from 1917 may not have still existed in 1940, and especially 1951.

Japanese American businesses are from Hokkubei Mainichi and Nichibei Times business directories of 1940 (courtesy of Japanese American History Archives, San Francisco).
